Privacy Policy

This page explains how Kavanaghs uses any information you give to us, and the ways in which we protect your privacy.

The Data Protection Act 1998 and General Data Protection Regulations 2018

Under the Data Protection Act, we have a legal duty to protect any information we collect from you. We will only use your information for the purpose we have described and we do not pass on your details to any third party or government department unless you give us permission to do so. We use leading technologies to safeguard your data and keep strict security standards to prevent any unauthorised access to it.

Feedback and registrations

1. Comment and questions

If you send an email asking for information we do not pass on any of your personal information when dealing with your enquiry, unless you have given us permission to do so.

2. Email subscription

When you subscribe to receive emails from us, your information may be read by Kavanaghs members of staff, who may record the information on a database and will contact you at appropriate intervals. This information is not passed on to anyone else.

Site usage information

1. Cookies

Cookies are pieces of data created when you visit a website which means that your “preferences” are stored while you move around the site. You can set your computer not to accept cookies. However, if you do this, you may not be able to use some site features because we need to record your preferences in order to give you the information you need during your visit.

Cookies do not contain any personal information about you and do not hold any information about which sites you visited before www.kavanaghs.co.uk

How we protect your information

1. In line with the requirements of the Data Protection Act 1998 and the General Data Protection Regulations 2018, we follow strict security procedures to ensure that personal information is not damaged, destroyed or disclosed to a third party without your permission and to prevent unauthorised access to your information. The information that we collect is stored in a secure facility with restricted physical access. We also use a number of security measures to prevent electronic access. Where information is shared with third parties in line with this policy, similar security measures are used to protect your information.

2. The access to and use of the information that we collect is restricted to our employees who need the information to perform a specific job role or activity. Where information is shared with third parties in line with this policy similar security measures are used to protect your information.
3. Your information will be held and processed on computers within the UK and will not be transferred outside of the European Economic Area.

Log files

Log files allows us to record visitors use of the site. They enable us to make changes to the layout of the site and to the information in it, based on the way that visitors move around it.

Log files do not contain any personal information or information about which other sites you have visited.

What happens when I link to another site?

This privacy policy applies only to our site, so you should always be aware when you are moving to another site and read the privacy statement of any site which collects personal information.

We do not pass on any personal information you have given us to any other site.
